The path of Shadow Yoga is rich and complex, involving clear stages of training meant to be fulfilled progressively (vinyasa krama). Skillful practice at each stage may bring proficiency in its associated methods, but practice alone is not enough to ensure success. One must also comprehend what one is doing, why it is being done, and how each component of the system fits together as a unified whole. This workshop is designed to shed light on this important subject by providing participants a deeper understanding of the principles which govern the practice of the Shadow Yoga prelude forms, and how the preludes fit into the bigger picture of the classical Hatha Yogic system. Particular emphasis will be placed on the art of preparatory work and the ways in which Shadow Yoga addresses it skillfully and systematically.

For Whom: All students with some yoga experience, regardless of style, are welcome. For students new to Shadow Yoga, this workshop will serve as an introduction to this style. Current Shadow Yoga students, experienced with the preludes, will gain a deeper understanding of the bigger picture of practice and shore-up their foundation, which is often the key to overcoming persistent obstacles and entering new depths of freedom and competency
